*Greetings from Seoul, South Korea.*

*Graham and I wanted to provide you with an update on our class. We have 72 people (the organization had to turn people away after changing the venue 3x due to increased class growth before our arrival) who are professionals and laity. 5 are defectors (whom they refer to as "returners").*

*We can only say that the response (to be honest) blows us away. The students are comprehending and applying the concepts immediately and report daily how effective corePurpose works. One of the defectors was a high ranking General from NK and who was airlifted by SK from China. Sadly, his escape to SK was a media frenzy here so he believes his family was likely tortured and executed as an example to other defectors. He said it is his great sorrow to bear.*

*I am scheduled to teach a group of NK on Thursday night. We are so humbled.*

*We can feel the prayers. Dont stop. Lives change.*

*God is healing wounds and sending out.*
